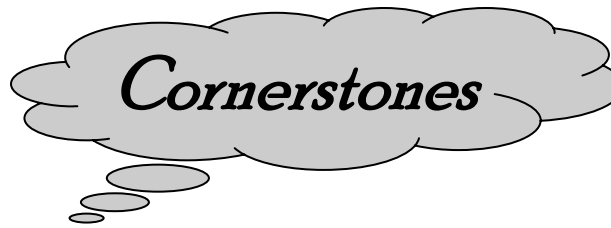

Conference Topics

Session One

1. Good Night, Sleep Tight:

We will examine the importance of sleep and its role in development and how it can effect behavior. We will also discuss techniques to address problem sleepers.

2. Strategies for Sensory Processing in Social Settings (part one):

Learn ways to help children with differing sensory processing styles have positive and successful interactions in social situations. *This topic will be overlap both session one and session two.*

3. Dynamic Story Time:

Story time can be so much more than simply reading a book out loud. This session will show you how to prepare children for story time, encourage interactive activities, and use associated items with a story. Ideas will help you promote a fun and positive learning experience.

Session Two

1. Positive Language in Classrooms and at Home:

WHAT: Positive language and choice making.
WHY: Reduced stress on both child and caregiver.
WHEN: During play, transitions, and challenging behaviors.

2. Hippotherapy:

We'll discuss the physical benefits of hippotherapy including: balance, posture, mobility and function. We'll also talk about how hippotherapy affects psychological, cognitive, behavioral and communication functions for clients of all ages.

3. The Ripple of Inclusion:

Inclusion can help establish relationships between children. Friends, even in the toddler years, can help children feel good about themselves, adapt to childcare settings and build self-confidence. Project Together works to build these relationships. We'll discuss how the Project Together *pit crews* (youth-led peer mentoring groups) are expanding positive community change throughout Lancaster County and what can be applied within early education.

4. Strategies for Sensory Processing in Social Settings (part two):

Learn ways to help children with differing sensory processing styles have positive and successful interactions in social situations. *This topic will be overlap both session one and session two.*
